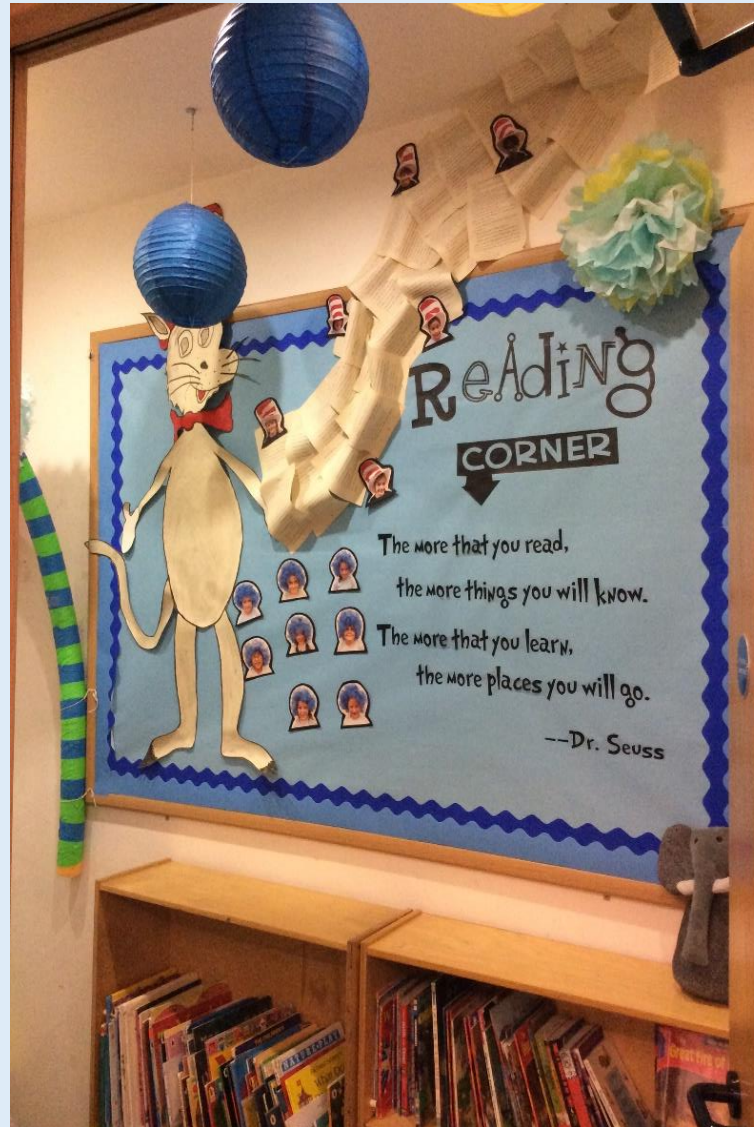


'My favourite book is 'There is a Werewolf in My Tent' because it's creepy and interesting.'

Year 5 Poplar

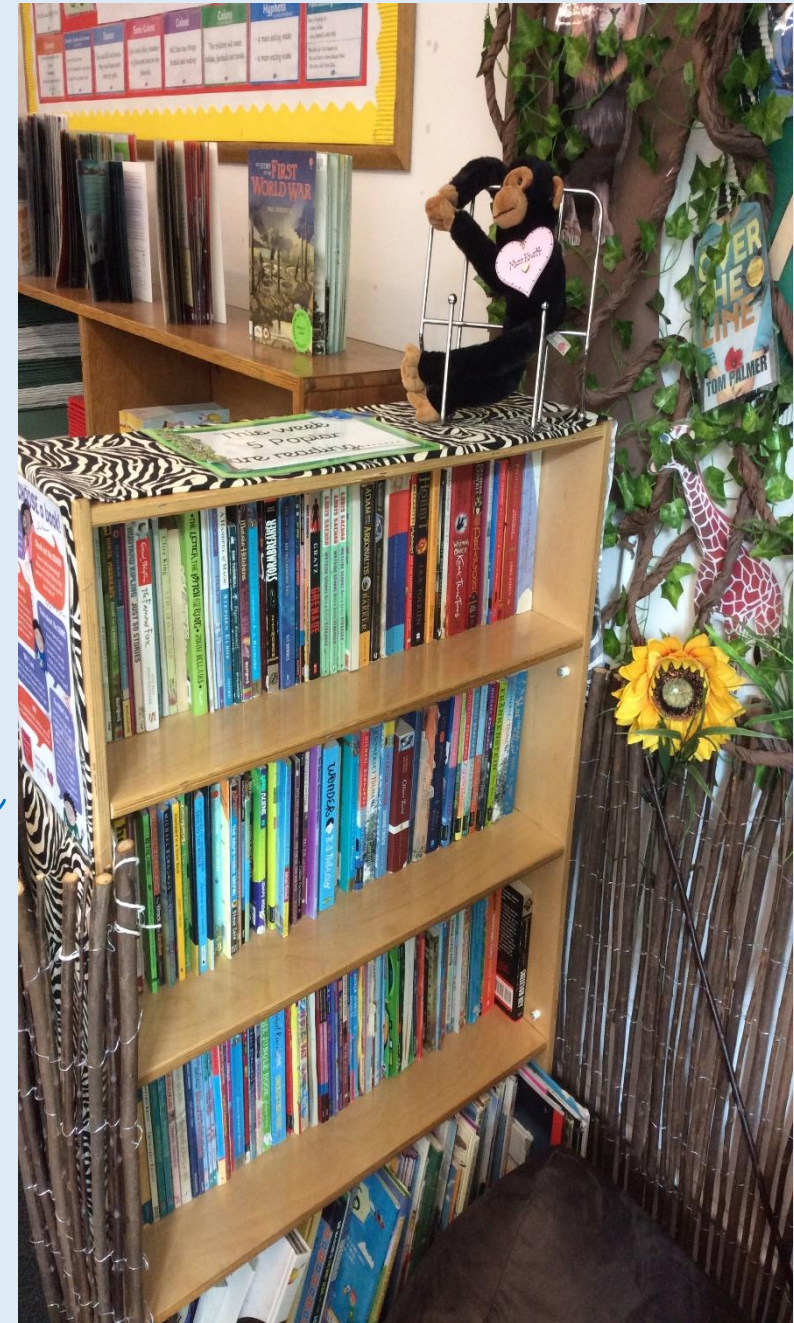
'I like the reading corner because it looks like a real jungle with books. It has lots of great books that you can share with your friends.' Gloria

'There is a really good selection of books and the butterflies are fabulous.' Laila

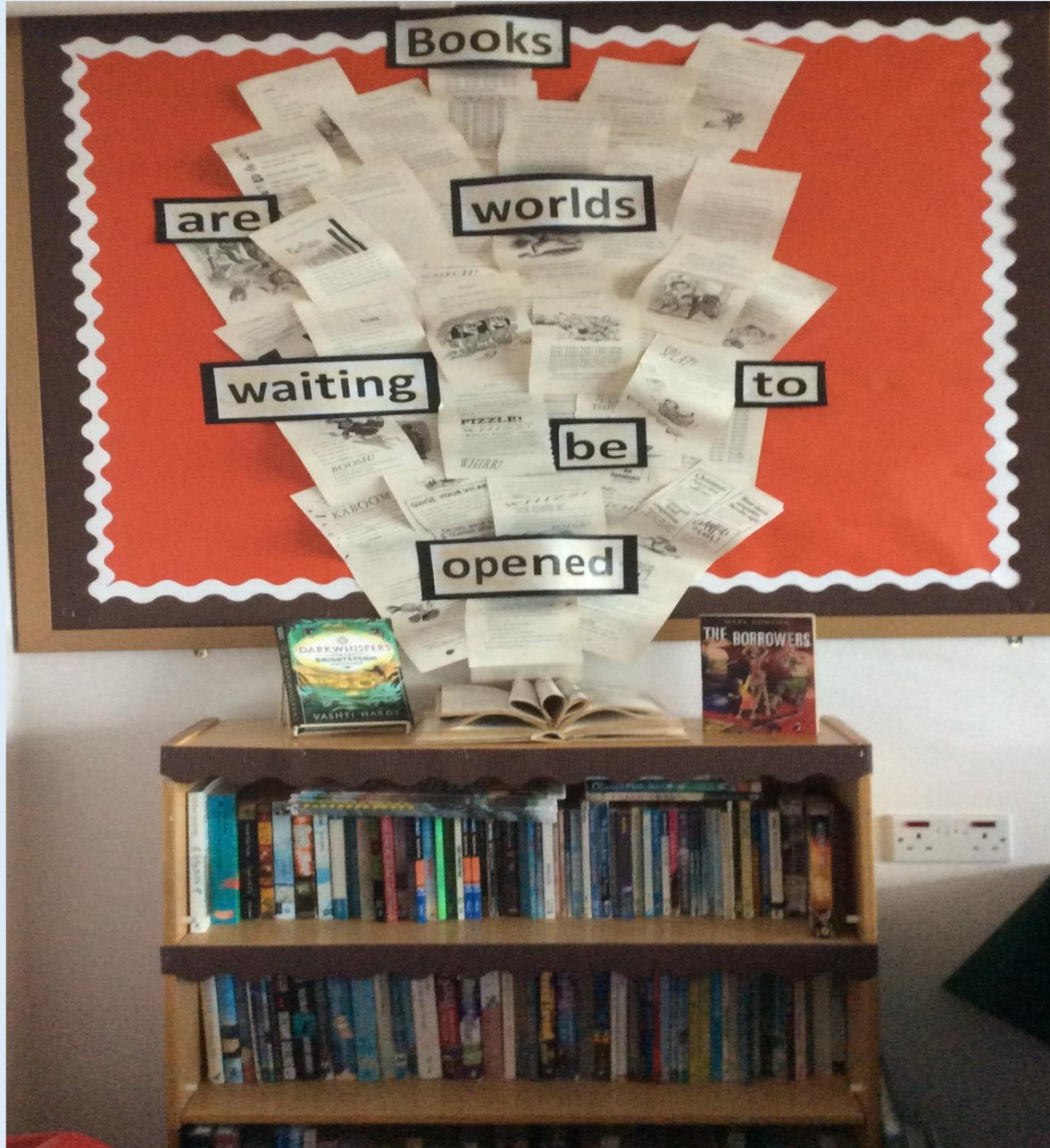
'It is colourful and all the books are organised.'
