Sunday's Gospel Reflection

John 4:5-42: *“Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again; but whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.”*

Jesus is sitting by the well, when the Samaritan woman comes to draw water from the well. Jesus is also thirsty, not so much for water as for quenching this woman’s real thirst. Strange as it might seem God is thirstier for us than we are for him! He asks the Samaritan woman “Give me a drink.”
