Sunday's Gospel Reflection

Today we begin the most important week in the church's year, Holy Week. Today, Palm Sunday, we recall Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, when the people waved palm branches and shouted, "Hosanna". They were welcoming Christ as their King, although this did not last for long.

During Holy Week, we celebrate Christ's passion, death and resurrection. On Thursday, we join Christ at the Last Supper, then go with him to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane, from where he is arrested and taken before Pilate. On Friday, we follow the Lord as he makes his way to Calvary for his crucifixion. We remember this journey when we pray the Stations of the Cross. But we know that this is not the end because on Easter Sunday we celebrate His resurrection. Alleluia!
