Re: Harrow Catholic Academy Trust Consultation

As you may already be aware, in accordance with the 'Diocese Catholic Academy Trust strategy', the Governors of St Anselm's Catholic Primary School, have recently taken the decision to initiate the consultation process regarding the acquisition of academy status and forming the Harrow Catholic Academy Trust with our partner Catholic Schools in the Borough. (St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, St Teresa's Catholic Primary School and Nursery, St George's Catholic Primary School and St John Fisher Catholic Primary School and the Sacred Heart Language College).

This does not mean we have decided to convert to an Academy, but that we wish to seek the views of all our community to inform our final decision. To support parents / carers in developing their knowledge and understanding of what is involved in becoming an academy we have prepared a questions and answers consultation leaflet which is available on the school's website at
