HOW OLD IS ANTARCTICA AND HOW IT WAS FORMED

Antarctica first had glaciers at the end of the Devonian period, around 350 million years ago

 Antarctica finally stopped making glaciers around 35 million years ago

One by one vast blocks tore away, South America and Africa first, followed by India and Madagascar around 40 million years later. This left the remains of Gondwana (what would become Australia and Antarctica) to drift towards the south
