## Sunday's Gospel Reflection

John 6: 51-58

In today's scripture story, we heard Jesus tell the people that he is the living bread. Jesus wasn't actually telling the people to chew on him like bread instead, he was telling the people that the things he taught them about God were just as important as the bread they ate everyday. Just like our bodies grow strong and healthy when we do those things every day, so too does our relationship with God grow strong and healthy when we pray, give thanks to God, and read/talk about the faith stories. 
