### In School

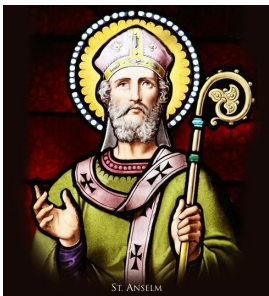
On Monday the school celebrated St Anselm's Day at Mass, led by 4 Pine and the Gift Team.
