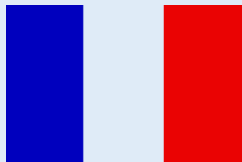
International Week

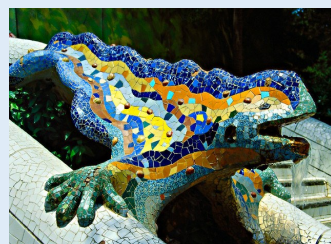
Drama Club Year 2
