"I really enjoyed the Panto". - Ruby 1 Aspen

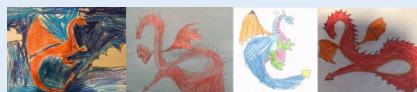

Week 1 and 2: Year 2 practiced how to draw to **scale** by following a step-by-step guide.



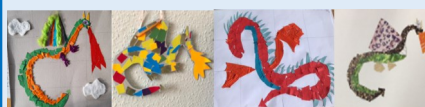
"I liked it because it was fun and easy to follow." - **Aoife R**

Week 3 and 4: Then they explored creating **tone** with a pencil and using light, medium and dark tones on their dragons.



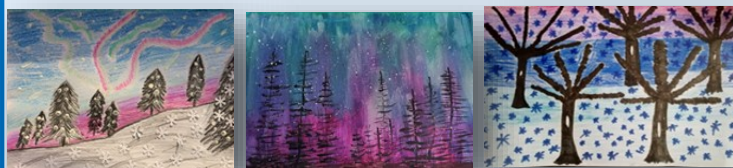
"I enjoyed the challenge for adding detail to the dragon but the **cross-hatching** was a little bit hard." - **Leon**
